

FEES and SUBSCRIPTIONS 2010

The following are the scales of fees and subscriptions payable for new admissions under Bye-Laws 24 and 25 of the Institute's Charter and Bye-Laws with effect from 1 January 2010.

NEW ADMISSIONS

An Admission fee and relevant subscription should accompany the application form.

ADMISSION FEE

Admission fee: £59 (Students pay no admission fees).

ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION

The Council of the CIOB has agreed the apportionment of subscriptions for **new members** dependent on the date of the first admission to membership. Those currently in membership will pay the full years subscription. All new members admitted between 1 September - 31 December will be billed the full rate in the following January.
