NEW ADMISSIONS

An Admission fee and relevant subscription should accompany the application form.

ADMISSION FEE

Admission fee: \$735 (Students pay no admission fees).

ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION

Those currently in membership will pay the full years subscription. All new members admitted between 1 September - 31 December will be billed the full rate in the following January.
