

FEES and SUBSCRIPTIONS 2012

Republic of Ireland (Euro's)

NEW ADMISSIONS

An Admission fee and relevant subscription should accompany the application form.

ADMISSION FEE

Admission fee: €67 (Students pay no admission fees).

ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION

The Council of the CIOB has agreed the apportionment of subscriptions for **new members** dependent on the date of the first admission to membership. Those currently in membership will pay the full years subscription. All new members admitted between 1 September - 31 December will be billed the full rate in the following January.
